Woodbine Entertainment Group  
LOCKED OUT/ON STRIKE**



On January 25, 400 SEIU Local 528 members at Woodbine Entertainment Group voted down a memorandum of settlement. As a result of that vote, SEIU Local 528 members from the Security department remain locked out, and cleaning and maintenance members hit the picket lines on a legal strike.

In addition, 400 food and beverage workers from HERE Local 75 were locked out on Friday, January 23, 2004 after rejecting the employer's final offer.

Despite bitter weather, picket lines are growing at both Mohawk and Woodbine. The employer's proposed memorandum of settlement attempted to punish the locked out security officers and food and beverage workers, did not go far enough in consolidating bargaining units and was not acceptable in terms of wages, benefits and job security provisions.

SEIU and HERE members are appealing to you to bolster our picket lines. At the Woodbine Raceway, SEIU and HERE picket lines are set up daily from 6 AM to 12 AM. The busiest and most important time for your show of solidarity on the picket lines is just prior to live racing times, every Monday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday from 5:30 to 8:30 PM and every Sunday from 10:30 AM to 1:30 PM. We would welcome your support and solidarity.

The SEIU picket headquarters is set up in a trailer at 135 Queens Plate Blvd (on corner of Rexdale Blvd. and Hwy #27). We are picketing at 7 entrances. Please go to the SEIU headquarters and we will assign you to a picket location.

Together we can put the much-needed pressure on this employer to negotiate a fair settlement with the members of SEIU Local 528 and HERE Local 75.
