## *Bromley L. Armstrong Award*

The award recognizes the dedication and contributions that demonstrate outstanding commitment and leadership to persons that fought and propagate the rights of Labour and Human Rights.

The Toronto & York Region Labour Council has established this prestigious award in 2004 to commemorate the courage, dedication and outstanding service of Bromley L. Armstrong to the Labour and Human Rights Movement in Canada.

This award is presented to members of the Affiliated Locals of the Toronto & York Region Labour Council who have demonstrated excellence in some area of Labour Equity and Human Rights. This award will be presented on a yearly basis as the nominations will be based on activities and contributions during the previous year.

### **Eligibility**

Members of the Affiliated Locals of the Toronto & York Region Labour Council. The nominations must recognize and outline the activities and contributions that meet or exceed the selected criteria (see nomination form). The award may be presented to recognize continuous service or a particular significant highlighted event in the labour movement. The nomination should have the endorsement of the affiliated local with approval by a designated senior official. All Nomination forms must be sent to the Toronto & York Region Labour Council.

The selection will be done by the Equity Committee as per the selection criteria and the recommendations will be given approval by the Executive Committee. The Equity Committee will consult with individual or unions to clarify any information or misunderstanding.

### **Selection Criteria**

- A person who has made a true contribution to labour *equity and human rights*.
- A person who exemplifies the spirit, dedication and ideas of the labour movement.
- Has organized and educate members around Human Rights and Equity Issues.
- Has helped confront human rights violations
- Provided assistance and support for members who experience harassment and discrimination.
- Promoted equity within their union and in the labour movement.
- Ensuring that the employer and the union comply with the provisions under the Ontario Human Rights Code
- Has demonstrated leadership in the labour movement and the community.

Nominations should include specific examples of the above criteria when they are presented. The award will be presented to the individual or group recipient(s) at the Aboriginal and Workers of Colour Conference each year.
